

Player Notes for Spring Creek 6-6-6

- 1. A player may have a single caddy for this event. The role of the caddy is to enhance the tournament experience. Caddies should assist with the pace of play and not cause unneeded delays by overcoaching. Caddies may walk/carry or push the clubs or may use motorized carts. Caddies may transport players clubs on the back of the motorized carts. Players may not ride in the carts with the caddy. All other spectators are not allowed to be in the fairway. Caddying is a privilege for this event that may/will be revoked at any time during the round if the Tournament Director deems it necessary.**
2. Spring Creek does not have a driving range; plan your arrival time accordingly. There is a small irons only area where you may chase your own shag balls and a chipping / putting green..
- 3. Parents and Spectators are not allowed to walk in the fairways with the players or follow behind the players in the fairways.** All Spectator carts must remain in the rough or on the designated cart paths. I strongly encourage spectators to stay 1 shot **ahead** of the group they are with to help spot errant shots.
4. All players need to be on #1 Tee 12 minutes prior to their scheduled tee time.
5. All players are required to keep and sign clean, accurate scorecards at the conclusion of their round. Any scores reported by volunteers are completely unofficial. Only Prep Tour players immediately completing their stipulated round will be allowed at the Scorer's Table.
6. Any rules not covered in the Notice To Competitors, Specific Starter instructions, The Prep Tour Hard Card, or printed Local Rules will be governed by The USGA Rules Book..
7. Players are not allowed to go inside to eat lunch after 9 holes. Parents are allowed to bring players food and/or drink from the clubhouse for the players to consume as they continue play on Hole # 10.
8. All players need to review the published 6-6-6 rules prior to the tournament. During the modified alternate shot format and the scramble format, the 1st player will play the ball down as it sits, the 2nd player will be allowed to place the ball within a single scorecard of his partners position. During the play your own ball portion, all 4 players will play their ball down.
